

Real life links:

Counting and Understanding Numbers – Play board games like Snakes and Ladders and Ludo that involve counting. Play games like dominoes where children have to recognise, count and match number/pattern of dots. Play card games like Snap where children look for pairs and Happy Families where children have to make groups according to different criteria. Practise writing numbers when making lists etc.

Measuring – Involve children in cooking. Encourage them to estimate, get a feel for different quantities. Look at numbers on scales and measuring jugs.

Understanding Shape – Make pictures with different shapes. Look out for shapes when you are out and about.
